It is believed that the human nose can distinguish around 13,000 different odor molecules from each other. The nerves that transmit the sense of smell are the delicate nerves in the organism. The sense of smell, which can positively or negatively impact our daily lives, works 24 hours a day. The sense of smell is the only sense that can never be "turned off."

It is the body's primary and most defining testing mechanism; it instantly evaluates whether an environment is good or bad. The familiar scent of a perfume we encounter while walking down the street reminds us of the friend who wears that perfume.

Humans cannot carry out their daily experiences relying on a single sense alone. All of our experiences occur alongside multiple sensory experiences. There is a unique sensory hierarchy in each experience. In any given experience, one sense might take the lead role, while in another experience, a different sense might be in the spotlight.

The sense of smell is processed in the limbic system without undergoing much filtration, and the limbic system is the region where all forms of vividness and emotional states (love, desire, affection, hatred) are found, especially in the long term.

The processing of sensory inputs other than smell in the limbic system occurs after undergoing filtration. The processing of sensory inputs other than smell is primarily filtered in the cognitive region. The processing of the sense of smell into the limbic region, on the other hand, occurs without much filtration. As a result, reactions to odors are closely associated with the intensity of emotions.

The fact that the sense of smell can never be turned on or off is due to its alignment with the most vital function. Smell control cannot be subjected to self-control and becomes more significant than the things that constitute it. MEGALION PERFUME

Perfume is composed of a mixture of 'burnt resin' and 'balsam oil.'

Perfume contains myrrh and cinnamon.

In ancient times, we can express that the Megaleion perfume was considered the most suitable perfume for women. It was also known for its long-lasting scent and could be classified as one of the expensive perfumes.

Romans also used this perfume. Among Romans, this perfume was enhanced with balsam, sweet flag, Chinese cinnamon, and pine resin, in addition to balsam oil.



MENDESIAN PERFUME

The perfume named after the city of Mendes in the Nile Delta, which is believed to have been first made in this region, was also used by the Greeks and Romans.

The materials that make up this perfume include ben oil, pine resin, and myrrh.

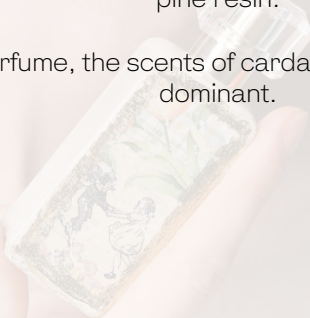
Additionally, we can see cinnamon being added in various sources. The reason for adding cinnamon is thought to be to enhance the strong scent of the mixture.

METOPIAN PERFUME

This perfume was derived from a plant-based scent called "metopiyon" in Egypt.

Furthermore, this perfume contains bitter almond, the oil of unripe olives, cardamom, thistle, honey, wine, myrrh, the fruit of Mecca balsam, resin of the galingale plant, and pine resin.

In this perfume, the scents of cardamom and myrrh are dominant.

LILY PERFUME

A perfume used by both the Greeks and Romans, its main component is lilies.

In ancient times, it was frequently preferred in daily life. Additionally, the Egyptians were also familiar with this perfume, which they used in reference to the water lily. In Rome as well, this perfume was known by the same name during that era.

The primary material of this perfume is lilies. Additionally, balsam oil, sweet flag, honey, cinnamon, saffron, and myrrh were used.

IRISES PERFUME

To obtain this perfume, the roots of the iris flower are utilized.

The main ingredient of the perfume is the iris plant, and to this mixture, the roots of violet flowers are added.



MYRTUS PERFUME

The dominant scent of this perfume is a combination of juniper berry extract and laurel plants.

To this mixture, myrrh, lily, fenugreek, frankincense, and cinnamon are added, creating an exquisite perfume.

This perfume is made from henna trees.

The key to this perfume lies in chilling the materials to be added in a cold container.

We should note that the point where the flowers' color turns black is a sensitive stage in perfume making.

There are different recipes for henna perfume. While some materials are consistent across recipes, variations can be observed in different ingredients and their quantities in certain cases.
